By reducing operator exposure, minimizing contamination risk, and simplifying compliance with stormwater regulations, EnviroEye has become a vital tool in environmental responsibility.

Over the past decade, EnviroEye has expanded beyond EFRTs to applications in dike outfalls, contact water tanks, truck racks, railcars, dock lines, sumps, and even well heads. Standard systems are usually 4" and 6" flange, while other sizes and custom configurations are available. Standard options like the Slick Sleuth sensor remain central to deployment, while other enhancements—including MOVs and cold weather packages, and integrated alerts—allow facilities to customize protection for their unique needs.
